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ATTENTION PARENTS – YOUR CHILD WILL NEED ADDITIONAL VACCINATIONS BEFORE 7TH GRADE!

If you are receiving this letter, your child is not ready with his/her required immunizations for 7th grade. Per California Health and Safety Code Sections 120325-120375, children in California are required to receive specific immunizations in order to attend public school. Prior to 7th grade entry, vaccine documentation of a Tdap booster (after age 7) and two Varicella vaccines will be required by your child’s school. Students must also be current in all required vaccines before 7th grade. Documentation of the required vaccines must be provided to your child’s school before the end of the 2019/2020 school year. **Your child will not be allowed to receive books, a schedule, or attend school in August 2020 without being fully immunized prior to 7th grade entry.**

Please follow the steps below so your child will be ready for 7th grade:

1. Call for an immunization appointment **NOW**. Do not wait! Appointments and clinics fill up early and your child **will not be allowed to start 7th grade without the Tdap and Varicella vaccines or any required immunizations.**
2. Take your child’s yellow immunization form, or this letter, to the physician or clinic for documentation.
3. Provide official documentation of the immunizations to your child’s school site **before the end of the 2019/2020 school year.**

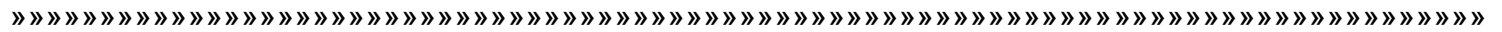
Under California State law, existing personal beliefs exemptions are no longer valid for vaccines required for school entry. Students with ***personal belief exemptions must be fully immunized*** before 7th grade entry. If your child requires special education services as documented on an IEP, he/she will continue to receive those services during any potential immunization exclusion period.
