



**Get Online, Not In Line**  
**Online Enrollment for the 2018-2019 School Year**

Google Chrome is recommended as the web browser for online enrollment.

Online enrollment for grades 1-8 begins on May 1, 2018. Transitional kindergarten (TK) and kindergarten (K) enrollment began on April 4, 2018. The above link can be used to enroll a new student for this school year. If your child currently attends a school in the Etiwanda School District (including CLOUDS), please do NOT complete the online enrollment process. If enrollment is submitted and an error is found, please do not enroll student again. The school staff will be able to fix any error(s). Please do not use all capital letters or nicknames. Please use proper upper and lower case letters when entering information. Online enrollment is NOT for CLOUDS. Please visit the [CLOUDS](#) website for more information.

Online enrollment is the first step in the process to enroll a **new** student. You must have a valid address within the Etiwanda School District boundaries to use this system. Information about the student such as emergency contacts, medical, and language will be collected. Upon completion, the student's information is electronically sent to the school. Required documents for students in grades 1-8 may be submitted to the school office from 5/1/18 to 5/25/18 (office closes for summer). Office will re-open on 7/25/18.

**\*\*PLEASE NOTE\*\***

**Enrollment is not complete until all required paperwork is submitted to the school office.**

**The following items are required to complete your child's enrollment:**

**A certified birth certificate**

**Immunization record** – Records provided by a physician or public health agency with a physician's or nurse's signature/stamp. Child will not be placed in a class or allowed to attend school unless immunization requirements are up-to-date.

**Proof of residency** – two original or online bills within the last three months from the following list:

Gas, electric, water, disposal, telephone, cable, homeowners/renters insurance policy, W-2 from most current tax year, **or** certified original closing document from escrow or rental/lease agreement which are **temporary** proof and must be followed up with two of the above items within 30 days.

**\*Please note** - If you are in escrow on a home within the Etiwanda School District and would like your child to attend the school of residency for your new address, you must submit an inter or intra district transfer and provide escrow papers with the estimated closing date (within 60 days) to the Etiwanda School District, Pupil Services Department.

Children entering transitional kindergarten and kindergarten are required to have the following immunizations:

<b>Polio</b> (OPV and/or IPV)	<b>DTP (DTaP/DT/Td)</b> (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)	<b>MMR</b> (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	<b>Hepatitis B</b>	<b>Varicella</b> (chicken pox)
<b>4 Doses</b> (3 doses OK if one was on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday)	<b>5 Doses</b> (4 doses OK if one given after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday)	<b>2 Doses</b> (both must be given on or after the 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday)	<b>3 Doses</b>	<b>1 Dose</b> or documentation of disease by physician

Child will not be placed in a class or allowed to attend school without required immunizations.

State Requirements: Under a state law known as SB277, beginning January 1, 2016, exemptions based on personal beliefs will no longer be an option for the vaccines that are currently required for entry into child care or school in California. Child <i>must</i> be five years of age on or before September 1	Child <i>must</i> be five years of age between September 2 and December 2	Child who turns five years of age on or between July 1 and September 1 K Continuance Form is required for TK (available at school office).

The Etiwanda School District has determined that it is in the best interest of a child to enroll in TK with a start date of January 7, 2019, if their fifth birthday falls between December 3 and December 31 during the same school year. For TK students with birthdates between December 3 and December 31, we will accept online registration in November; however, students will not start TK until January 7, 2019. Note: TK classroom campus location will be determined by space availability. Families will be notified of school placement by December 14, 2018.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Parents of returning students must complete the annual online Data Confirmation under Student Info in their Aeries Parent Portal prior to obtaining student's class assignment. The online Data Confirmation window will be 7/16-7/27/18 (only for parents of returning students). Class Assignments will be available at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, 7/30/18, for TK and K and 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, 8/2/18, for all students. First day of school is on Monday, 8/6/18.
