## Tournament Rules/Information

- The Etiwanda School District Battle for the Library MONOPOLY® Tournament (ESDMT) will be played according to the Standard Rules of play provided by Hasbro in each game box.

- During the tournament, any and all rule clarifications will be handled by the Tournament Directors and/or Official Judge whose decision is final.
- Registration for the ESDMT is open to all adults and all students in grades 5 -12.
- Players may register for one of two divisions:
  - The senior Division includes all adults 18 & over.
  - The Junior Division includes all students in grades 5-12.
  - Junior players may choose to register for the Senior Division, but must then compete as Senior Division players for the entirety of the competition.
- All players will compete in two rounds of game play and must complete a Tournament Score Sheet after each round. A "Percentage of Total Assets" system is used to determine who advances to the semi-finals and who advances to the consolation round.
- The winning players from each division in the semifinals will advance to the Final Round along with last year's division champion if available. If last year's champion in a division is not available then the 4 semifinal winners will advance to the finals. There is a first place prize for each division.
- An official Banker will be assigned to each table to handle transactions and monitor game play. Bankers will also verify player score sheets after each round.

- Check-in begins at 9:00am. All registered players must be checked in and in seats by 9:40am.
- Registration space is limited and open until seats are filled. Late registrants may be wait-listed until space opens up, so registering early will help assure players a seat in the tournament.
- Registration fee must be included with registration form.
- Substitutions for registered players will be allowed at no additional cost.
- Lunch is included in registration fee. Additional lunch tickets may be pre-purchased for \$7.00 each, or for \$10 at the door (subject to availability).
